1st marking period Report Cards were mailed home on 11/21/07.

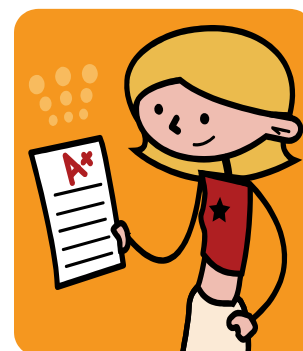
