- Students are to report to each Block and are required to leave the building at 11 AM unless scheduled to make up an exam;
- Attendance must be taken before each exam session is to begin;
- If a student has Senior Privilege, they are not required to report until their scheduled exam block;
- Review Day for mid-term exams is Thursday, January 17th & Friday, January 18th;
- The Audion will be utilized for make-up exams from 11:30 AM – 2:16 PM each day;
- Students late to an exam should only be admitted with a pass from the Attendance Office
- Eastern Center
 - Students should report to Tech School **on days they are not scheduled** for an Exam. PM students should attend at their discretion;
 - If transportation is required, students should report to the high school cafeteria before 11 AM;
- Exams should be designed to run the entire exam period of the allotted exam time (80-90 minutes);
- The mid-term exam in a full year class is computed as 10% of the total grade in the course; for semester courses, the final exam which will count as 10% of the final grade;
- In case of inclement weather (school closing/delayed opening) the exams scheduled for that day will be postponed until the next day that school is in session;
- During the exam period, all athletic practices and other student activities will run at their regularly scheduled times unless authorized by the Athletic Director;
- Any student who fails to sit for a midterm exam, who is not excused, will receive a grade of “0” for the exam;
- Breakfast will be served at its normal time on all four days;
- The break period is designed for students to use the restroom, purchase a snack or drink, and relax before the next exam begins.
