

Resolution

Compensation of Real Estate Collector

WHEREAS, the Board of School Directors of the School District of Upper Moreland Township desires to compensate the collector of the District's real estate taxes (hereinafter "Tax Collector") and also to reimburse said Tax Collector for actual and needful expenditures as required by relevant law; and

WHEREAS, said expenditures are those actual and needful expenditures for printing, postage, books, blanks and forms as set forth in the relevant law; and

WHEREAS, the Board of School Directors of the School District of Upper Moreland Township desires to reimburse its Tax Collector for said actual and needful expenditures through regular biweekly payment; and

WHEREAS, said actual and needful expenditures which must be allowed the Tax Collector pursuant to relevant law is not to exceed \$8,500 annually; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, the Tax Collector shall be compensated for the 2022-2025 term as follows:

The tax collector shall receive as compensation the amount of \$2.60 for each collected real estate tax bill issued from the original duplicate. In addition, the tax collector will receive \$5.10 for each interim tax bill collected issued after the original duplicate. The compensation shall be paid annually on a calendar basis beginning January 1, 2022 which shall be paid biweekly in twenty-six equal installments of seven hundred (\$700.00). In addition, a reconciliation payment will be made beginning in January 2023 for the difference between the installment payments made and the actual collections paid to the School District of Upper Moreland Township; provided that in no event shall the amount paid the Tax Collector as compensation pursuant to this paragraph exceed five per centum (5%) of the amount of real estate taxes actually collected each school year beginning July 1, 2022 by the Tax Collector on behalf of the District.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Tax Collector shall be allowed his or her actual and needful expenditures for printing, postage, books, blanks forms, computer software and supplies as follows;

The Tax Collector shall receive the amount of Eight thousand Dollars (\$8,500) annually toward such expenditures; this amount shall be reimbursed upon presentation of actual receipts to the Upper Moreland School District.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that on or before November 10, 2020, a copy of this Resolution be hand-delivered or mailed by certified mail, return receipt requested, to the District's existing Tax Collector and that a copy hereof is published in the same manner as are notices of the Board's public meetings.
