For those of you who are not familiar with the USDA Summer Food Service Program, its purpose is to provide free meals throughout the summer to all children under 18. Many children rely on free and reduced school lunch and breakfast during the school year, but during the summer months many of those children may lose access to those nutritious meals. Every school age student up to the age of 18 is eligible for a free summer meal. Students will be able to access free lunch at Upper Moreland High School every weekday from 11:00am to 12:30pm just by showing up to the high school cafeteria. There are no forms to fill out and no papers to sign. All that students need to do is walk into the high school over lunch time. We look forward to providing nutritious and secure meals in the summer of 2019!
