

Parent/Guardian Expectations for UMHS Athletics/Performing Arts

- Support your child and other student-athletes during all athletic/ performing arts events.
- Do not engage in negative comments directed toward Upper Moreland coaches/instructors; insist your child does the same.
- Do not comment negatively on opposing coaches, players, teams, or officials; insist your child does the same.
- Do not approach a coach/school district personnel with negative interactions after the game.
- Understand the hierarchy for athletic questions (listed below) and understand coaches/instructors will not talk to any parent about strategy, playing time, or other student-athletes.
 - 1. Student-athlete to coach/instructor
 - 2. Parent & Student-athlete to coach/instructor
 - 3. Parents & Student-Athlete meet with the Assistant Principal/Athletic Director
- Make every effort to attend coaches' meetings/ or read and understand coaches' expectations for your child's sport.
- Acknowledge and support the ultimate authority of the coach/instructor to determine strategy and player selection.
- Understand and support that the coach/instructor will not talk to a parent about another student-athlete at any time.
- Work closely with the coaches/instructors, guidance counselors, and school personnel to identify a reasonable and realistic future for your student-athletes after high school.

- Practice schedules will be communicated with your child from their coach/instructor.
- Understand and support the student-athlete code of conduct.
- Understand and be familiar with the eligibility procedures listed in the student-athlete code of conduct and understand Upper Moreland Athletics/High School value academics over athletics.
- Understand that if a student violates the code of conduct, the Assistant Principal/Athletic Director will work with the coach/instructor to determine if any additional disciplinary

- measures will be taken for the student-athlete. This may include dismissal from the team.
- Understand that all fundraisers are encouraged but not mandatory for performing arts and athletic teams.
- Understand and acknowledge senior nights are special for our seniors and teams.
 Seniors will be acknowledged <u>before</u> the athletic contest. No starting time or playing is guaranteed to anyone during senior nights, and playing time is under the coach's discretion.
- Please do not contact a coach if your son or daughter was not mentioned in press articles not written by our coach or instructor; we do our best to highlight students when applicable.
- Understand that all student-athletes must attend and depart from all athletic contests using district transportation. If the parent/guardian requests to take their child, they must email the Assistant Principal/Athletic Director and head coach/instructor.
- No parent should be on the athletic fields without prior approval from the Assistant Principal/Athletic Director.
- Understand and acknowledge that we value our instructors and coaches and believe they have the best interest of our students. Coaching and being an instructor is a difficult job; please show them mutual respect.
