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Refunds will be provided under the following circumstances: 1)The student suffers a season-ending injury prior to the mid-point of the season for which the Activity Fee has been paid. The injury must prevent the participant from engaging in half or more of the regularly scheduled contests and a medical authorization letter must accompany all such requests.

2) A student and their family move out of the district. Refunds will be prorated based on the number of regularly scheduled contests remaining when the student moves away. Requests for refunds must be made to the athletic department before the season's midpoint.

**Students who quit an activity any time during the activity season are not eligible for a refund. Students who are removed from an activity for disciplinary reasons are not eligible for a refund.**
