<i>Course</i>	<i>Description & Overview</i>
Reading Intervention	The Reading Intervention Program in grades 6-8 will support the development of essential skills specific to reading and writing that can help students achieve their fullest potential. The Read 180 Program will provide differentiated tasks that are tailored to the needs of each student, ultimately promoting greater confidence, independence, and greater academic success. The Grade Level Literacy Intervention will focus on the writing development. Students will receive small group support to develop the structure and components of their writing that will help them achieve greater success in all content areas.
Math Intervention	The Math Intervention Program in grades 6-8 will focus on developing a deep understanding and mastery of the essential skills and foundational concepts necessary to make connections and think algebraically. This course will utilize the Math 180 Program that differentiates tasks that are tailored to the needs of each student, ultimately promoting greater confidence, independence, and greater academic success.
Enrichment Program	The enrichment program will focus on science, social studies and writing. Each content area will provide students with hands-on, practical learning experiences that will expose learners to pathways and topics that are not covered in depth in the middle school core curriculum.
6th Grade SEL Course	<p>All 6th grade students will take a Social Emotional Learning (SEL) Course as part of their Unified Arts Rotation. The goal of the SEL Course is to provide students with essential skills that can help them overcome the challenges that all adolescents face, but also skills and mindsets to help each student contribute positively to our community.</p> <p>Students in the 6th Grade SEL Course will focus on the following topics: Stress Management, Identity & Community, Skills for Success, Social Awareness, and Equity. The culminating assignment for the class will include a service project that helps give back and contribute to our local community.</p>
